



ITALIAN TECHNO 293 WEEK 2019

1 - EVENT:

Italian Techno 293 Week is scheduled from Monday July 8th,2019 to Saturday July 13th,2019 including Techno 293 Slalom Cup, Long Distance Techno 293 and Italian Class T293 National Trophy Open Racing Regatta.

2 – PLACE, DATES AND EVENT ORGANIZER:

Torbole, Garda Lake:

Monday July 8th,2019 and Tuesday July 9th,2019: TECHNO SLALOM CUP

Wednesday July 10th,2019: LONG DISTANCE TECHNO 293

Depending on wind and weather conditions the dates for TECHNO SLALOM CUP and LONG DISTANCE TECHNO 293 may be interchangeable.

Thursday July 11th,2019, Friday July 12th,2019 and Saturday 13th,2019: ITALIAN T293 CLASS NATIONAL TROPHY OPEN RACING REGATTA.

3 - RULES

The event will be governed by

*the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing, included Appendix

B. Italian Sailing Federation prescriptions will apply too.

*Notice of Race

*Sailing Instructions

* The Techno 293 Class Rules will apply.

If there is a conflict between the Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions the Sailing Instructions shall take precedence included every official notice posted on the Official Notice Board (change of RRS 63.79). In accordance with Rule 90.2 may be given oral instructions ashore and afloat.

4 - DIVISIONS:

All competitors must race with BIC Techno 293 One Design board. All week events are open entry ones.

Divisions shall be:

Competitors born in years 2007-2008-2009(Under 13 Minim Division): sail Bic OD 5.8 mq. and its rig, fin 46 cm. Change down sail may be a second free sail whose size is max 5,5 mq, free rig and mast with max 60% carbon. Referring to Italian law, competitors born in 2009 may race in this division from the day of their birthday only. Starting and results maybe joined with under 15 Junior division ones.

Competitors born in years 2005-2006-2007-2008-2009(Under 15 Junior Division): sail Bic OD 6.8 mq. and its rig, fin 46 cm. Change down sail may be official sail BIC OD 5,8 mq with its rig only. Referring to Italian law, competitors born in 2009 may race in this division from the day of their birthday only.

Competitors born in years 2003-2004-2005-2006 (Under 17 Youth Division): sail Bic OD 7.8 mq. and its rig, fin 46 cm. Change down sail

may be official sail BIC OD 6,8 mq with its rig only.

Techno Plus Class for competitors born in 2002 and previous years:

a) sail BIC OD 8.5 mq. and its rig and sail BIC OD 7.8 mq. and its rig (changing down sail);

b) or sail BIC OD 7.8 mq. and its rig and sail BIC OD 6.8 mq. and its (changing down sail).

Fins: 50 or 46 cm.

Starting and results maybe joined with under 17 Youth division ones.

Competitors born in years 2003 and 2004 may race in Techno Plus Class if they state sail BIC OD 8.5 mq, and its rig, fins 50 or 46 cm.

5 - ELIGIBILITY:

Entries shall meet the requirements of World Sailing Regulation 19- Eligibility Code.

Competitors shall be members of a National Class Association.

The following shall be presented upon registration:

- Evidence of valid third party insurance as for Italian Sailing Federation Rules

- Proof of age
- Parental permission form

6. WIND LIMIT AND COURSES

Long Distance T293: The minimum speed wind at starting line shall be 6 knots. The course will be shown during the skippers' meeting and described in the sailing instructions. The choice to race, to continue or to short the race course, depending on wind conditions, rests entirely on the discretion of the Racing Committee.

Techno Slalom Cup: The minimum speed wind at starting line shall be 11 knots. The choice to race, to continue or to stop the competition rests entirely on the discretion of the Italian Class Representative. The Race Committee has obliged to consult the Italian Class Representative about all problems concerning wind limit too. Every day as more as possible races will be sailed, referring to local conditions, on the discretion of Race Committee.

Italian Techno National Trophy racing regatta: No more than three races per day shall be scheduled or raced. If minimum under 13 5.8 division will race on the course of Italian kids or Experience fleets may be scheduled four races.

7 – LIFE JACKET:

All competitors are required to wear a suitable life jacket. However this obligation cannot constitute object of protest among the competitors.

8 – SCHEDULE AND RACE FORMAT:

No fixed programs. All competitors shall be at disposal of the Race Committee in the morning of the first day of each competition for a Skipper's meeting. The schedule and time of Skipper's meeting will be posted on the Official Notice Board within 8.00 p.m. of the previous day. During the Skipper's meeting the outline daily program will be shown. Anyway, except for different news posted on the Official Notice Board, no starts will be scheduled after 5.00 p.m. and in the last day of the week after 4.00 p.m. All competitors are obliged to attend all Skipper's meetings, because changes to Sailing Instructions may be announced.

Long Distance T293

One race will be sailed only.

Techno Slalom Cup

Every day as more as possible races will be sailed, referring to local conditions, on the discretion of Race Committee.

Italian Techno National Trophy racing regatta

No more than three races per day shall be scheduled or raced. If minimum under 13 5.8 division will race on the course of Italian kids or Experience fleets may be scheduled four races.

9 - SCORING:

Long Distance T293:

the final results of the race.

Techno Slalom Cup:

the score of 0.7 is assigned to the first classified.

In order to score a series, both semifinals must be completed in order to know the composition of the A and B finals. In this case the score will consist of the total points normally assigned in the final divided by the number of competitors in the final with a rounding to 0.1. All competitors in this final will get equal scores.

As for discards, a discard is applied if 3 or 4 races are completed, two discards if 5 to 7 races are completed and three discards if 8 or more races are completed.

One race completed validates the event.

Italian Techno National Trophy racing regatta:

Scoring will be in accordance with WCR Appendix A "Low Points Scoring System".

Except for what stated in Point 8 for Minimum under 13 division, a maximum of 9 races are scheduled and no more than 3 races per day will be held.

When less than 4 races have been completed, the score of a competitor will

be equal to the total of the sum of all the races carried out. When a total of 4 or more races have been completed, the score of a competitor will be the sum total of the scores of the races carried out, discarding the worst result. If several divisions indicated in point 4) race with only one start and the same course, a single order of arrival must be drawn up for all the categories in that race, from which the positions for the consequent classification will be highlighted. The highlighting means that to the places in the race classification of each of the categories in question is assigned the score acquired in the order of arrival .

10 - EQUIPMENT INSPECTION:

No previous equipment inspections are scheduled, but random inspections may be made at any time during the event. Competitors are responsible to comply with Class Rules. Endorsement of equipment may be expected.

11 – SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:

The sailing instructions (SI's) will be available during event registration.

12 – ENTRY FEES:

The required fees are:

€ **40.00** for both Techno Slalom Cup and Long Distance Techno 293 only;
€ **55.00** for Italian Class T293 National Trophy Open Racing Regatta only;
€ **95.00** for all week of competitions.

It is compulsory to pay entry fees in advance.

Surname, Name, Sailing Number, Division, Date of birth, Town of birth, Address (Street, number, zip and town), Sailing club, Number of Sailing Club membership card.

Deadline for payments: WEDNESDAY JUNE 26th.

All competitors shall confirm their entries with registration at Regatta Office in Torbole in the first day of the competition they race.

Late entries may be accepted at Regatta Office but competitors shall pay a fee of delayed payment as prescribed by Italian Sailing Federation.

For underaged competitors the entry form has to be signed by parents, coaches or teamleaders.

13 – PRIZES:

For each competition, Techno Slalom Cup, Long Distance T293 and Racing Italian Open Event, prizes will be awarded to the first three competitors of each division as follows:

1°/2°/3° Techno 293 Youth 7.8 Under 17 male

1°/2°/3° Techno 293 Youth 7.8 Under 17 female

1°/2°/3° Techno 293 Junior 6.8 under 15 male

1°/2°/3° Techno 293 Junior 6.8 under 15 female

1°/2°/3° Techno 293 Minim 5.8 Under 13 male

1°/2°/3° Techno 293 Minim 5.8 Under 13 female

1°/2°/3° Techno 293 Plus Class male

1°/2°/3° Techno 293 Plus Class female

Possible additional prizes will be posted on the Official Notice Board.

Prizegiving ceremonies will be made as soon as possible when each competition ends.

14 - SUPPORT BOATS AND PEOPLE:

All support people and boats must be registered filling the relevant form at the regatta office.

They have to declare:

- 1) the model of one's own assistance boat;
- 2) acceptance of the "rules for support staff and assistance boats" described in the Sailing Instructions;
- 3) the names of the competitors accompanied.

15 - MEDIA:

In registering for the event, competitors automatically grant to the Organising Authority the right in perpetuity to make, use and show from time to time at their discretion, any motion pictures, still pictures and live, taped or filmed television and other reproduction of them, taken during the period of the event, for the said Event as defined in the Notice of Race and Sailing Instructions in which he/she participates without compensation. Media boats, coach and teamleaders boats must be authorized by the Race Committee and must be registered at regatta office.

16 – DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the event entirely at their own risk, see WCR 4 - Decision to Race. The organising authority or any of their officials or representatives or the sponsors or their officials or representatives will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the event.
